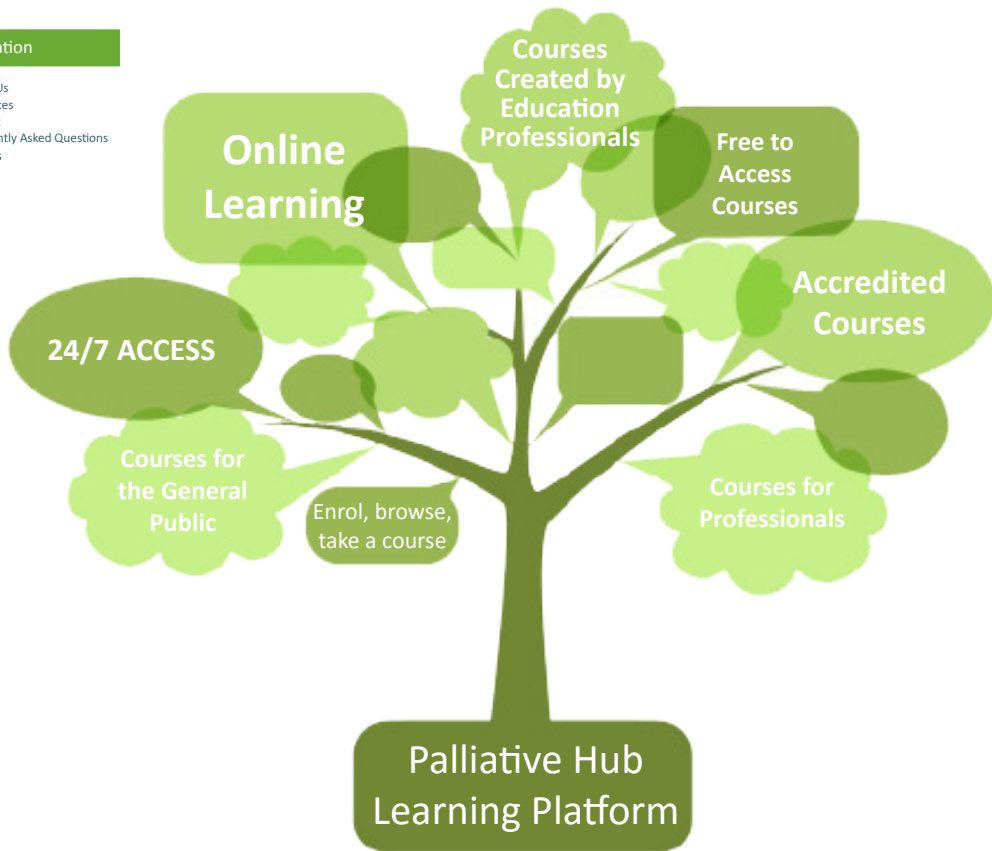

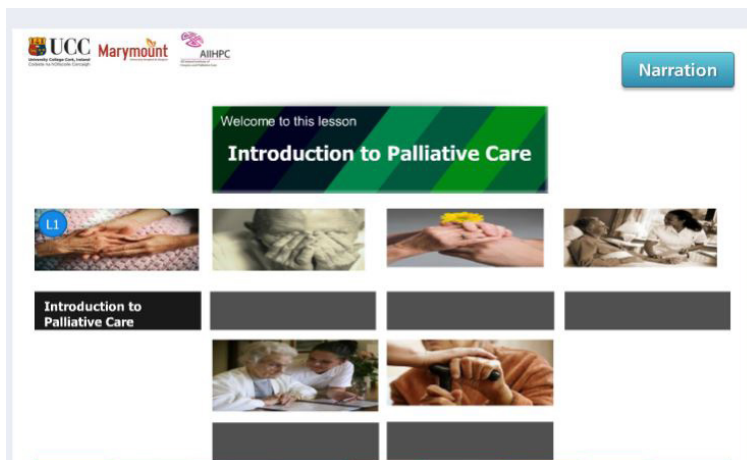
Learning Platform

The Learning Platform currently hosts a wide range of courses including:

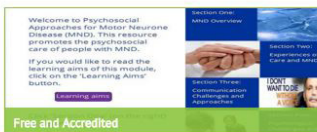
- Awareness raising on palliative care for H&SC Professionals – AIIHPC
